## **Harmony Weekend Camp at Camp Kelly, Dwellingup — 17-19 October 2008**

On the afternoon of Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2008, 52 adults and 47 young people travelled to Camp Kelly which is set in a peaceful and relaxed area of the State Forest. After arriving, settling into accommodation and an evening Aussie barbecue, everyone began to meet one another in an opening "Welcoming Ritual" organised by Richard Mavros (Edmund Rice Formation Team). As part of this ritual, every participant wrote their name and country of origin on a piece of card and placed it on a large world map. The countries represented were: Australia, Burma, Russia, Sudan, Eritrea, Jamaica, Congo, Afghanistan, Togo, Rwanda, India, Uganda, Singapore, Macedonia, Iran, and the United Kingdom. On Saturday morning we all had the opportunity to learn about the Indigenous history and spirituality of the area, to learn some Nyoongar language, to listen to the didgeridoo and songs, to witness an "emu dance" and finally to participate in a bush walk through the forest and sample the local bush foods. George Walley and his cousin Frank were excellent presenters and both concluded their time with us by sharing their own personal story.

After morning tea, we shared our own personal story in small groups with others whom we had not met before. Following an introduction about the diversity of Religions in Western Australia there were short presentations on the Baha'i Faith, Islam, Christianity, and Buddhism. This session concluded with discussion, sharing and recording the similarities that exist between the various faiths. These similarities were to be recalled later in the camp in our Multi faith Service. Saturday concluded with a multicultural feast with a large variety of dishes from around the world, a campfire and some very lively multicultural dancing and music led by Jackie (originally from Jamaica). On Sunday morning we celebrated a multi-faith service which brought together the Indigenous story and our own personal faith stories and reflections over the weekend.

The Harmony Weekend proved again to be very successful with new friends made, a greater appreciation for the richness of our diverse community in Western Australia and the beauty of the natural environment.

Thank you to the WA Government Office of Multicultural Interests for their assistance in making the camps possible, and to the members of the committee for their commitment and hard work.

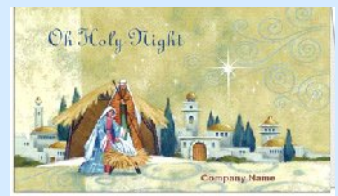
